Services

Project Next Step: A Meet Me Where I Am (MMWIA) provider providing a family and community based intervention designed to enhance the stability and integrity of the family by keeping or returning the child to the home or least restrictive setting. Services include: conflict resolution/problem solving, parenting skills, communication skills, independent living skills, education support, respite, case management and development of community support networks.

Intensive Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment (IOPSA): Evidence based program to motivate a young person's decisions and commitment to change. The program is geared towards youth with a history of serious substance abuse problems. IOPSA utilizes the Seven Challenges ©.

Outpatient: Individual and family centered therapy for children and adolescents of all ages experiencing a range of emotional and behavioral issues. We utilize a family centered, solution approach to therapy. In addition, our Outpatient program provides psychiatric services based on the individual needs of the child and family.

Spectrum Specialty Team (SST): Enhancing the quality of relationships and quality of life for children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders and their families.

Project STAR (Survivors of Trauma Adapting and Recover): Trauma specialty program designed to meet the needs of children of all ages impacted by interpersonal trauma and deprivation.

Valley Clinical Services: Therapeutic private practice providing individual and family therapy, and couples counseling.
